


Three Tangos for String Quartet



Written for an intermediate level ensemble, the poetry is about the power of memories to bring back a connection to those that have passed on.





Contemporary with Minimalist Piano Accompaniment


The poetry, in the form of a chant, traces the journey of a droplet of rain and supposes that we might join on that journey.

Tools for the Contemporary Composer

This book is designed to improve the skills of composers by presenting a wide variety of compositional tools in styles ranging from Classical to Jazz, Folk, Rock, and Pop. By studying the recordings and scores of composers throughout history readers will gain a musical awareness that will strengthen their own compositional process. Particular attention is paid to the “building blocks of a composition;” the musical elements such as melody, harmony, and rhythm that are at the core of the creative process.




Fire-Flowers (Song-Cycle) SSAA

The Bridge Builder (SATB)


Contemporary Classical with lots of syncopation.
